(TBNC)

- That the leadership, the employees, and the volunteers at TBNC would be led by God, not by their own will,
- That no attack by Satan could harm us,
- That we would have unity and a common vision and sense of purpose for TBNC,
- That TBNC would work in harmony with other Christian broadcasters in Canada,
- That TBNC would share information about Christians around the world in a meaningful way, and
- That every program shown on TBNC would honour God.

(Canada)

- That Canadians would embrace the Gospel,
- That righteousness would prevail where moral issues affecting Canada are concerned. Among these issues are pornography, the flaunting of sexual mores, the decisions of the Supreme Court, purity in leadership, the state of the family, and
- That our new government leaders would operate in wisdom, uphold freedom and democracy, improve Canada's image in world, solidify our relationships with other countries, and
- That Canada would be protected from terrorism, outbreaks of disease, and disasters.
